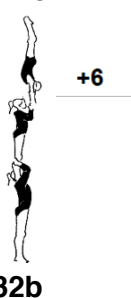

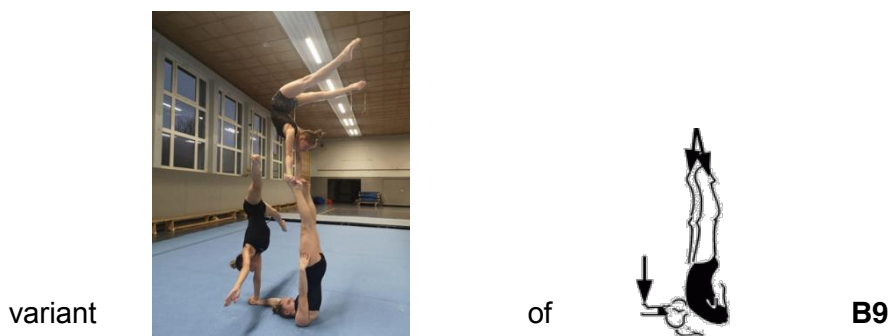

Gizela Zielinska,

With sadness we want to let you know that Gizela Zielinska, wife of Konrad Zielinski, passed away on January 19th 2021. Gizela was 86 years old. She was a huge asset to Acrobatic gymnastics from the start.

She has been a coach of several women's pairs and groups, who won medals at the World and European Championships and received the title of "Meritorious Trainer", 1987.

Gizela Zielińska compiled the first Tables of Difficulty for IFSA in 1974 and worked, together with her husband, for many years in the Technical Committee Acrobatic gymnastics of FIG.

The International Federation of Gymnastics (FIG) awarded Gizela Zielińska with the Bronze Badge of Recognition.

On behalf of the FIG Acrobatics Technical Committee and the acro community, we honor this great lady of Acrobatics and send our deepest sympathy to her family and friends.
